**Greetings Everyone!**

**The business end of the season is fast approaching and so it is time to remind all coaches, managers and players of the rules for semi-finals and finals play:**

### Semi Finals Day

It depends on where you finish in pool play:

- 1 – has the bye as they go straight to Final
- 2 – plays against 3 – winner plays 1 on Finals Day
- 3 – plays against 2 – winner plays 1 on Finals Day
- 4 – has the bye as they play winner of 5 & 6
- 5 – plays against 6 – winner plays 4 on Finals Day
- 6 – plays against 5 – winner plays 4 on Finals Day

### Finals Day

- 1 – plays winner of 2 vs 3
  - 4 – plays winner of 5 vs 6
- Losing teams do not play

### **Semi Final & Final Player Eligibility:**

“Players must have played 3 or more games/or part thereof, for their registered club to be eligible to take the court in a semi-final or final game”.

### Note to Umpires:

On Semi Finals Day – There will be **NO** draws.

When the buzzer sounds to signal the end of normal game time, blow your whistle, call “umpire’s time” & ask the player to “hold the ball”.

### Check the score.

**If there is a winner** (score is **not** tied) – give a long blow on your whistle to signal the end of the game.

**If the score is tied**, play is to continue until one team is ahead by **TWO** goals. Giving a short whistle, recommence play.
